

Lettuce Pots

Once your plant grows 4+ inches tall, you can start harvesting the lettuce for salads or sandwiches.

Directions:

Keep seeds moist by spraying lightly with water daily until they start to germinate.

Once the plant is established you only need to water weekly. In our growing zone (8b), lettuce grows best in the winter months.

- Lettuce likes weather below 80 degrees.
- Keep you lettuce moist but not soaking wet.
- Bring inside if calling for a frost
- Partial shade to full sun
- Harvest large leaves
- Never pull the leaves or the plant- use scissors to cut.
- Cut leaves one inch above the soil

Your lettuce pot should grow for continuous harvest until early June or temps reach above 80's.
